



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## **Celebrate Ordinary Time**

Celebrate Ordinary Time prayerfully. Remember we can pray anytime and anywhere. We can pray throughout the day.

Read the short prayer on the leaf. On the other leaves, write your own short prayers. Then color the leaves green and cut them out.
