Activity- God Revealed- October 1

Materials

- Pictures of God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit, Jesus)
- Ziploc style bags, 1 for each image
- Water
- Freezer safe container
- Scissors

Instructions

Preparation

- Print the images of God on 8-1/2x11 paper and cut into 12 pieces (4 wide x 3 high)
- Place all of the pieces from one image per bag and seal the bag.
- Place the bag in the freezer safe container and fill it with water
- Freeze until solid

Game Play

- Each team gets a block of ice with the pieces frozen inside.
- Teams will break open their ice blocks and reveal their pieces
- They put the pieces together and shout out the Person of God that they reveal

Discussion

- What strategies did you use to break open your ice?
- What struggles did you have?
- How were all of your team members involved in this game?
- How did you feel when you were able to reveal the baggie? How did you feel when you were able to reveal the image?
