The publication is not in alignment with <u>Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship</u>. This publication and its accompanying website

are not endorsed by, nor are they affiliated with the Diocese of Grand Rapids or the Catholic Church. We know that the paper has already been received by at least one household in our diocese, along with other dioceses of the State.
