**Guidelines for Sick Children Returning to School:** With illness spreading, please help keep our students and families healthy by following these guidelines:

Do not send your child to school if:

- They have had a fever (oral temperature above 100°F) within the past 24 hours. They must be fever-free for 24 hours without medication such as Tylenol or Motrin.
- They have vomited or had diarrhea in the past 24 hours.
- They show symptoms of a contagious illness (e.g., strep throat, conjunctivitis/pink eye, flu, or an undiagnosed rash).

Your child may return to school when:

- They have been fever-free for 24 hours without medication.
- They have not vomited or had diarrhea for 24 hours.
- If applicable, they have completed a 24-hour dose of antibiotics and/or have a doctor's note clearing them to return to school.
