Create a Sacred Space at Home

- Designate a small prayer corner with a crucifix, candle, and purple cloth.
- Include a Bible (open to Luke 22–24) and a picture of Jesus.

Daily Family Reflections

Holy Thursday (Evening) Theme: Service and the Eucharist

- **Read**: John 13:1–15 (Jesus washes the disciples' feet)
- Reflect: How can we serve one another with love at home?
- Activity: Share a simple meal and give thanks for the gift of the Eucharist.

Good Friday (Afternoon) Theme: Sacrifice and Love

- **Read**: John 18–19 (The Passion of Christ)
- Reflect: What can we "give up" or offer today in love for Jesus?
- Activity: Attend service at St. Joseph Church or pray The Stations of the Cross.

Holy Saturday (Daytime or Evening) Theme: Waiting and Hope

- **Reflect**: Even in silence, God is working. What are we hoping for?
- Activity: Light a candle and pray: "Jesus, bring Your light into our hearts."

Let us journey with Jesus through the Triduum so we may rejoice fully on Easter Sunday. **St. Joseph, pray for us!**
